International Strategy to approach FOSS Technologies to Companies and Government.

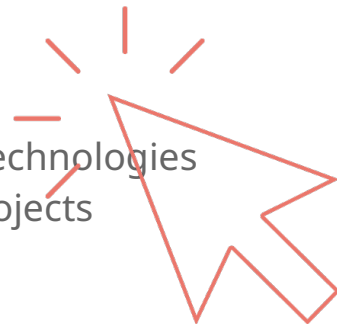

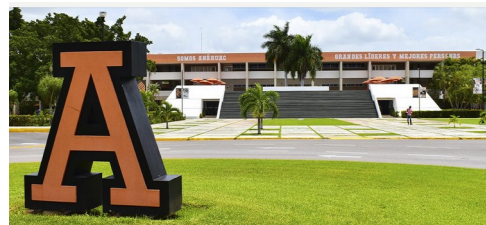
